

PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION POLICY

Team Extravaganza is referred to as "customer" (hereinafter "customer") Shing business partners who deal with customers. Information that can identify specific individuals (hereinafter referred to as "personal information") shall establish and protect the following "personal information protection policy" as follows: In order to realize the protection of personal information, the company observes the Personal Information Protection Act and other related laws and regulations, and strives to appropriately handle and protect personal information.

We will take measures to ensure that personal information is handled within the scope of the intended use of the customer and is not intended to be used out of purpose. In addition, we will not disclose or provide personal information provided by you to third parties unless there is a customer's consent or justifiable reason.

If you use the personal information for purposes other than the intended use of the original, we will do it in advance of your consent.

If we entrust the handling of all or part of personal information to a third party, we will take necessary measures to ensure that the entrusted partner complies with the safety management measures.

Our team strives to prevent unauthorized access to personal information, leakage, loss, and damage of personal information, and to improve and correct information security. Our team will respond sincerely and promptly to inquiries or requests for disclosure, etc. from you regarding personal information.
